# So let us ask ourselves a few questions.

- How do I see myself, when I am alone? Am I happy with myself and with my life, as a simple human being? Where did I put my priorities? Maybe in my work, maybe in my career, maybe in my friends and my children? But now how do I feel when all this is taken away from me? One day I will have to face this situation again, at the moment of my death.
- How do I interrelate with my family? Am I happy to spend time with my wife, my children? Or do I wait for the moment to unload my children to my wife? Now that they do not go to school, am I able to spend the whole day with them?
- What about my values? Am I able to prioritize? Is it always me and me and nobody else?
- What about my faith? Is it just an emergency break? And for the rest of my life I put it in the backburner?
- And what about my job? If I will not to be able to go back to my job, what are my other options? Am I ready to reprogram my life? Can I look for a simpler lifestyle? Can one of us, stay home investing on the education and formation of our children?
- Can I make room for my elderly parents? Will I have a place in the family when I will get older?

- **BUTTOM LINE**: Do I have enough trust in God to face whatever is going to happen to my life pretty soon? Or do I allow myself to fall down into depression and anger?
- Maybe it is time to redirect my life; maybe to restart a new relationship with my spouse and children.
