JESUS IS NOT ONLY FOR CATHOLICS.

This Sunday's Gospel gives us a clear dimension of the magnitude of God's love and grace. We have here a Canaanite woman, a pagan, one that does not belong to the "chosen people of God" who is able to steal a miracle from this rabbi, who seems to be sent by God.

There is a progression on the story, which shows us how many steps it takes for Jesus to bring us to the faith necessary for a miracle.

First there is a clear rejection from Jesus; actually, He not even answers to the woman. In those days, no woman (even less a pagan woman) was allowed to speak to a rabbi in public. But the intention of Jesus was not to reject but to strengthen the desire of that woman. He does not send her away; He just wants to see the reaction of the woman. Had she gone away discouraged at the first answer, she was not going to get anything; but she remains and insists.

Even the disciples are annoyed and told Jesus to send her away! But Jesus keeps going by teaching the religious tradition of the time. The Messiah was supposed to save ONLY the "sheep of the house of Israel". As a rabbi, He knows well his Bible. Still the woman does not desist and keeps insisting: "Lord, help me".

Here the whole scene changes; she calls Him: Lord. Here there is something totally new; this woman has faith and calls this man, this rabbi: Lord. She is confident that He can help her! She trusts and believes in this man. Jesus continues to test her faith. "It is not fair..." to treat the children of the house, as one treats the dogs.

The response of Jesus sounds like an insult. He seems to be treating her like a dog. (This expression was used by the Jews to address the pagans).

But here is the turning point; she accepts even to be treated as a dog, because even dogs receive the crumbs from the table of the master. What a humility! What a persistence! And what a faith in this woman. Jesus has to give in and recognize that this woman has all the virtues of a child of God and so has a right to sit at the table of the master! "Great is your faith", Jesus says and on that faith the woman receives the miracle.

GOD IS FOR EVERYONE NOT JUST FOR A FEW OF HIS CHILDREN. Surely, God has his chosen ones, like the people of Israel, like the Christians of today, but He loves ALL his children,

no matter where they come from. The only condition is a deep faith and trust in the power of His love.

The other day I met a young man, a Hindu, who told me that about ten years ago during an accident he had a vision of Jesus Himself, who saved him and told him to go to a catholic church. I thought that Jesus should appear only to Catholics! He did not even know who Jesus was! After 10 years he is now a fervent catholic, baptized, faithful to the sacraments and saying the rosary with his family every day. Jesus calls everybody to His Kingdom; he has no prejudices; after all we are all children of His Father and brothers to one another.




