CHILDREN OF THE RESURRECTION

The resurrection of JESUS is the basis of our faith. St Paul says that if CHRIST had not risen, our faith would have been in vain. It is his resurrection that assures us of our own resurrection. The doctrine of the resurrection is an article of faith. It should also be an article of life. If we believe in the resurrection, let it reflect itself in the life we live. Let us not see the present world as the be-all and the end-all.

The faith in the resurrection is reflected in the life of the seven brothers in the first reading of today. They preferred to die rather than contravene the law of GOD. They refused to eat pork meat because it was not allowed by the law of their GOD. They were convinced that it is better to die than to disobey GOD, because their death will not be the end. This is shown in what they said before they were killed.

One said, "We are prepared to die rather than break the Law of our ancestors". Another said, "Inhuman fiend, you may discharge us from this present life, but the King of the world will raise us up, since it is for His laws that we die, to live again forever". Yet another, "It was heaven that gave me these limbs; for the sake of His laws I disdain them; from Him I hope to receive them again". And lastly, another said, "Ours is the better choice, to meet death at men's hands, yet relying on GOD's promise that we shall be raised up by Him; whereas for you there can be no resurrection, no new life". The words of these brothers show that their faith was their life.


