Will there be justice in this world?

For many of us, life experiences tells us that there is no justice and there never will be. We could ask ourselves here a multitude of questions to which we would probably have no answer, perhaps only a shake of the head in despair. Why so much violence, even within our own families? Why so much insecurity and hatred in the streets? Why do a few have so much and so many others live in misery? And many other questions, why? Some would tell us that the social and political, cultural and human problems are the cause of all these problems. However, in the end we would be wondering in our heads that "why?"

Advent, the season we are celebrating now in the liturgy and which invites us to prepare for the coming of the Lord, offers us an answer. The first reading, from the prophet Isaiah, tells us of one who will come. He is a branch from the stem of Jesse, a descendant of David. He will have the spirit of the Lord to rule according to his precepts. He will not judge by appearances but will do justice to the weak and pass just judgments. To say all this is to recognize clearly that justice, in this world, does not come to all equally. But, the reading of the prophet Isaiah, recognizing that the present situation is not good, invites us to live in hope. Because there will be a day when there will be justice for all. A day when violence will end and we will all turn to the one who has the spirit of the Lord. In him, we will find the justice we need.

But our personal effort is necessary, and John the Baptist reminds us of this in the Gospel. Conversion is necessary. If we are waiting for the Lord, we must begin to prepare the way for his coming. That is to say, we must live now, here and now, recognizing his presence among us. This is the best preparation. John the Baptist tells us clearly: "Change your life and your heart". Because it would be very wrong to complain that there is no justice while we practice injustice among ourselves.

For personal reflection: Are we able to recognize injustice in this world? Do we contribute in any way with our attitudes and behavior to the continuation of injustice? How? Why? What can we do to promote justice, starting in our own family, with our friends, in the workplace?
