

Christmas is so close that we might think that Advent has been just a preparation for everything to go well. To sing carols better, for the Christmas lights and decorations to be more special than ever, for the celebrations with family and friends to be so successful, or for the incense to perfume the temple and for everyone to listen attentively to the well-known story of the child born in Bethlehem.

Or perhaps, we should think that Advent is much more than a liturgical season that lasts four short weeks in which we want to prepare ourselves to allow the birth in us, especially in our hearts, of the "God-with-us", the Emmanuel, the desired Messiah, the one presented to us in the first reading and in this Sunday's Gospel.

The first reading, from the prophet Isaiah, can be very enlightening. There are those who think that there is no longer hope, that the Christian faith is about to enter a period of definitive decadence, that society has lost its foundations. They may be right. But it is a situation even a little better than the one King Ahaz was going through. His city was surrounded by an enemy army. He no longer had much chance of defense. At that time it was normal for armies to devastate the city and put to the sword those they did not turn into slaves. So Ahaz and his people had less future than ours.

In this situation, the prophet speaks in the name of God. They will receive a sign, a sign of a future. The sign is that a virgin woman will give birth to a child. That child is the living sign of hope, of God's ability to create life where we see only death.

This sign is fulfilled in Mary. She is the virgin who will give birth to a child, restoring hope to humanity. In this newborn child, the great love with which God loves each one of us will be made visible. It is a paradox because this child, like any other child, will need all the care and attention in the world in order to grow. It doesn't seem wise for God to light up hope in such a way. It is so fragile! But God is like that. He makes himself fragile to be closer to us.

Thanks to that fragile child we can continue to look to the future with hope and see in every man and woman the presence of God's love.

We must care for this hope as we care for a newborn child. It is so fragile and so light. It is in our hands. We cannot let it fall. We have to nurture it so that it grows and reaches all the human beings around us. Advent is much more than preparing unforgettable moments in the life of family or friends. Advent must touch the depths of our faith so that hope can take root in us.

For reflection: Can I discover signs of life around us? Are we aware that all life is a sign of God's presence? What are we doing to respect the life around us?
