On this Christmas feast, as a Christian family we gather at the manger, to welcome into our arms, into our lives, into our hearts our newborn Savior.

The great news proclaimed and sung by the angels will be heard today in all the churches: "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favours".

The announcement that the angels made to the shepherds is the announcement addressed to us today, in our time, in our history. The greatest event in history, the moment that transforms the history of humanity: God who comes to us, God who draws near to us.

Christmas is the feast of drawing near, Christmas is the feast of God's encounter with humanity. Christmas is the feast of closeness; Christmas is the feast of encounter, the feast of God's encounter with humanity. Jesus his Son, the Savior of the world, takes on our human frailty, as a child. This child was born so that we could learn to love. Today we can say: The promise of Hope has been fulfilled!

In the child born to us, God fulfills the promises of hope that Israel and humanity had longed for so long ago. Today is a day of joy and gladness because we can see what so many generations had hoped for. What human beings have always dreamed of and longed for, a life in fullness, hope in the face of despair, light and beauty in the face of darkness, joy and happiness in the face of suffering and sadness, freedom in the face of oppression, justice in the face of abuse, and peace in the face of violence, have become a reality in this child who has been born to us.

In that little body that we venerate and adore today, there is a huge mystery. The mystery of the promise fulfilled, the very hope made flesh. Salvation has come, the glory of God, the fullness of all that exists, the Word of God, has come into the world. God himself has become man out of love to give us hope.

May this feast of hope, closeness, light and peace, allow us to renew our commitment to live as sons and daughters of God. May it make us instruments of bringing God's love and forgiveness to all the places where we live.

From the Parish of St. Catherine of Siena in Mississauga we wish that the Joy and Peace of Christmas will last throughout the New Year.

I want to finish this message with the Solemn blessing of the Nativity of the Lord:

May God of infinite goodness, who by the Incarnation of his Son has driven darkness from the world and by that glorious Birth has illumined this holy day, drive far from you the darkness of vice and illumine your hearts with the light of virtue. May God, who willed that the great joy of his Son's saving Birth be announced to shepherds by the Angel, fill your minds with the gladness he gives and make you heralds of his Gospel.

May God, who by the Incarnation brought together the earthly and heavenly realm, fill you with the gift of his Gospel.
