## **ITINERARY**

#### DAY 1 **MON-JUL 21**

FLIGHT TO MEXICO - SHRINE OF OUR LADY

We fly from Toronto to Mexico City aboard Air Canada. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Group seating for our flight will be pre-assigned by the airline.

Upon arrival, welcome by our local English-speaking guide and transfer to our centrally located hotel. We check-in for a five-night stay and get time to rest after the long journey.

We gather to pray at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, visit the modern Basilica dedicated in 1976 and kneel before the altar displaying the astounding "Tilma", the sackcloth bearing the image of the Holy Virgin. We return to our hotel and enjoy our first Mexican dinner. (D)

## DAY 2 TUE-JUL22

MEXICO CITY Today we visit the Holy Family Church and the tomb of Fr. Miguel Agustin Pro, S.J. the Jesuit martyr. Continue to the Historical Mexico City and visit the Zocalo, see the National Palace (outside view), visit the Metropolitan Cathedral and see the Tomb of Bishop Zumarraga. To the first church built by the Dominicans in 1576 in the Plaza de Santo Domingo, the Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary and the Shrine of Our Lady of Covadonga (headquarters of the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary, founded in 1538). (B,D)

#### DAY 3 WED-JUL 23

Traveling via the Plaza of the Three Cultures, we arrive at the Shrine of Our Lady and celebrate morning prayers. Continue our tour to the Pyramids of Teotihuacan, a UNESCO World Heritage site, where ancient rituals once took place amidst the clouds. Visit the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon, Temple of Quetzalcoatl, and local arts and crafts markets. Along the way, you will be enchanted by the artful blending of pre-Hispanic and Hispanic cultures. (B.D)

#### DAY 4 THU-JUL 24

Enjoy a day at leisure to experience the rich history and culinary delights that Mexico has to offer. Explore bustling markets, where local artisans showcase their craftsmanship in vibrant textiles, intricate pottery, and dazzling jewelry. Shop and explore until you drop! (B,D)

We head to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe for prayers and bid farewell to Our Lady of Guadalupe. You will have some free time for private devotion and reflection. Tonight, we celebrate a farewell Dinner with Mariachi music at a local restaurant. (B,D)

Our pilgrimage has come to an end. We transfer to the airport for our return flight home. Arrival. End of our Pilgrimage. (B)
